We have reviewed Longview Title Company, LLC's (Company) (consisting of escrow agency closing offices East Texas Title Company of Gregg County, East Texas Title Company of Marion County, East Texas Title Company of Panola County, East Texas Title Company of Smith County, and East Texas Title Company of Upshur County) title insurance and settlement practices and the Company's responses in the accompanying *Assessment Procedures* portion of the American Land Title Association (ALTA) Best Practices Framework as of May 31, 2016.
